NFPA 25 (2017 Edition)

This seminar provides a review of the major revisions to the 2017 edition of NFPA 25. The significant changes from the 2014 edition will be highlighted along with reasons for the revisions. Attendees will participate in an in-depth discussion regarding the reformatting of the chapter summary tables along with the incorporation of inspection and testing scopes into the text of the standard and the relocation of common components such as gauges and supervisory devices to Chapter 13. Some of the significant revisions include the addition of annexes regarding tagging programs and data connectivity. New requirements regarding automated testing are covered along with changes to inspection frequencies for some system components. The 2017 edition also contains new ITM requirements for air compressors and the reporting requirements for fire pump testing. Upon completion, attendees should be able to:

1. Explain how the standard has been reorganized and reformatted;
2. Identify and locate the significant revisions to the standard;
3. Locate and apply the new requirements for air compressors and reporting of fire pump testing;
4. Locate and explain the new requirements for automated testing.

Required materials: *NFPA 25* (2017 Edition) standard.
